

Candidate must meet the qualifications for Group Leader as specified by the Office for Children -- A Group Leader must be at least 18 years of age and meet one of the following sets of requirements: 1) Have a Bachelor's Degree or an Associate's Degree; and have 3 months of experience working with school age children; or 2) Have a high school diploma or equivalent; and have 6 months experience working with school age children including 3 months supervised experience at a school age child care program. A demonstrated interest and commitment to working with children and families is necessary. *Experience in designing and leading activities for children is strongly preferred.*

GENERAL DUTIES

Responsible for the daily planning and implementation of small group activities and direct supervision of children. Actively participates in both small and large group activities. Group Leaders work 20-25 hours per week 1:30am - 6:00pm. *Group Leaders must also be available to work full-time during school vacations from 8:15am – 6pm.*

SPECIFIC DUTIES

- 1. Responsible for designing and leading small group thematic activities to meet the social, educational, and recreational interests and needs of school age children.
- 2. Responsible for providing a consistent, structured daily program activities and participating in and supervisor of these activities.
- 3. Assist with homework, serving meals, leading field trips, and cleaning the facilities used by the After School Program.
- 4. Responsible for the observation, recording, and reporting of significant individual and group behaviors.
- 5. Responsible for maintaining a safe, welcoming, and clean group room environment.
- 6. Attends program events, staff meetings, group supervision sessions, and participates in training as recommended by the Program Director.
- 7. Other duties as assigned by the Program Director

Any new hire must present the following prior employment start date:

- Evidence of a physical examination within 12 months or employment
- Records indicating immunity to MMR.
